Bringing Light to Our Lodges

- I. Goal. To develop cooperative relationships with Grand Lodges and Blue Lodges to promote and encourage substantive Masonic Education programs
- II. Implementation. SGIG/Deputy will request permission from Grand Master to implement a Blue Lodge Masonic Education Program
- III. Valley Responsibilities.
 - A. Identify all Blue Lodges in that Valley
 - B. Assign a “Blue Lodge Ambassador” to each Lodge
 - C. Utilize members of that Blue Lodge where possible
 - D. Appointed by Personal Representative with appropriate recognition
- IV. Ambassador Responsibilities.
 - A. Contact Master of assigned Lodge
 - B. Request permission to conduct two Masonic Education programs supplied by the Strategic Planning Committee
 - C. Identify interested individuals and request Worshipful Master to appoint a Masonic Education Committee
 - D. Valley presents each Lodge establishing a Masonic Education Committee a free copy of Brent Morris’s book, *The Complete Idiot’s Guide to Free Masonry* for future education programs
 - E. Books available at reduced cost when ordered in bulk
 - F. Scottish Rite Research Society also excellent source for Masonic education books
- V. Follow-Up

Ambassador periodically follows up with Lodge to encourage program and be a resource person
